Frappato is an ancient grape native to the island of Sicily. It is elegant, balanced and pairs well with a wide range of foods. Historically, finer Sicilian wines have been produced from classic, cooler-climate growing regions. This wine is a modern interpretation of a classic Sicilian grape, hence the Nova Strada “*new direction*” descriptor used for this historic wine.

Region Characteristics	Slightly hilly zone, with a good solar exposure and primarily clay soil.

Food Matches	Excellent with grilled meats, stews and rich cheeses.



Color Light ruby-red.

Nose Raspberries and rose pedals are the main focus on the nose. Graceful hints of strawberries and earthiness show through on the end.

Finish A light-bodied wine with fine acidity and low tannins.
